The Importance of Commitment, Ch. 8

1) You've been doing hard work....

- WHEN, you make 100% commitment you take every step with integrity, the universe will rush in to support you.

- WHEN you've made a commitment, no turning back, only way out is through:

- Make a commitment to make this a better world; it's why we're here!!!

- What do you feel passionate about?

Our spiritual goals must be fun!





2) Verbalizing your commitment!

- A commitment verbalized automatically creates its own support team!
- Halfway house intention—
verbalization —
realization!
- Speak your commitment out loud AND take concrete action

- **Remain open to the signals from the universe.**
 - **This feels right, is the right thing for me to do.**
 - **Story of Edwene’s job offer and ‘the sign’!**
- 5) Getting the “Stop” signal
- **May be barking up the wrong tree**
 - **Obstacles can make it clear you are being protected!**
- 6) Coming up against the “Second force”
- **Opportunities to practice the presence of God**
 - **Edwene’s story of practicing NOT having an upset**

7) Working without a net

- Edwene's commitment, steps, apparent limitations, perfect unfolding

- God is your net!

• 8) You have to learn how to serve

- Edwene's story of learning to serve....

- We need to have humility to mop the floor....

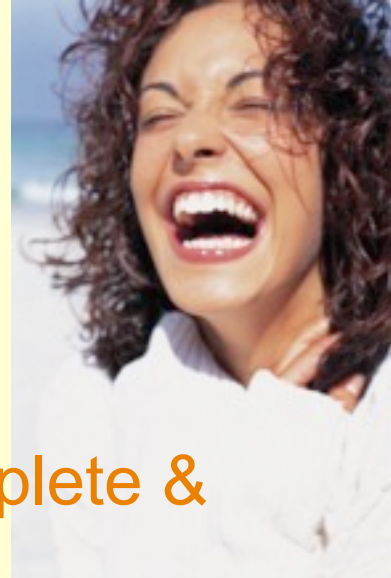
• 9) A commitment to greater self-love

• 10) An exercise: 2 weeks of self-care & integrity Day 1-14

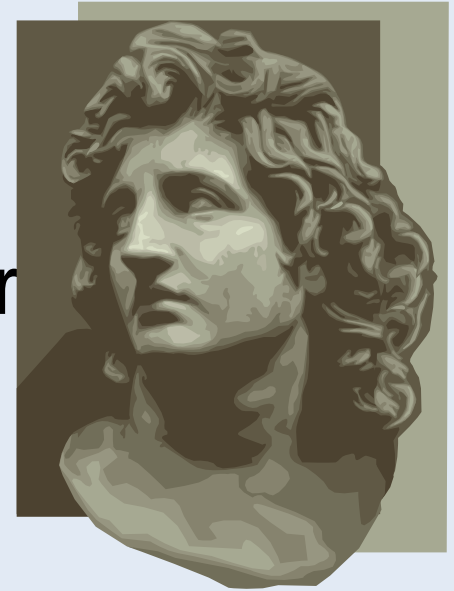

- 1) At one time or another
 - Great & wise people...have a clear defined life purpose
 - Divine purpose is a way of living
 - Notice all things that need healing, fixing, transforming....
 - Working toward the solution with dedication & persistence



2) JOY is your compass

- Anything you love to do -
DO IT!

It doesn't have to be

a big,
dramatic,

selfless gesture

- You don't have to aspire to
martyrdom!

3) Making it up as you go along....

The fastest way for you to find your divine purpose is to MAKE IT UP! Your life means what you say it means!

ASK yourself what would be the most fun thing I could do with my life... THAT is your life purpose

4) Living with integrity – when the outside of my life matches what I say I believe

Some people aren't going to like you!!

I just have to love them/allow them to behave the way they please.

5) Affirmations for integrity

I always PAY ATTENTION/am CONSCIOUS.

I always TELL THE TRUTH, QUICKLY.

I take total responsibility for MY EXPERIENCES....

I always keep MY AGREEMENTS!

6) Vision statements

More than a goal; can be a mega goal/wild dream.

Think of your soul's deepest desire/write it!

Bob's vision statement – financial reversal, heard Edwene, started: tithing, goal-setting & forgiveness. Got \$10M offer to buy his business, now working toward his dream (an institute to support the spiritual growth of humankind worldwide)



7) Unexpected prosperity

Bob had started playing IN A MUCH, MUCH BIGGER ARENA! When you start living in alignment with your divine purpose, unexpected prosperity WILL happen.

LARGE, RICH, OPULENT, LAVISH FINANCIAL SURPRISES NOW COME TO ME AND I AM GRATEFUL!!

Epilogue –

There is NO ‘once and for all’ about living the spiritually attuned/prosperous life! ...On-going, calls forth from us discipline. Release any negative/limiting thoughts.
